Kitty Thomas Hearing Impaired Fund

Any member of the Oregon State Grange in good standing with receipts for out of pocket expenses associated with hearing impairment may apply for reimbursement up to a cap of Five Hundred dollars (\$500) each year subject to approval of the Foundation Trustees. Requests are limited to one submission per calendar year.

Junior Camp Scholarship Fund

Any child or grandchild of a Grange member or Junior Grange member can receive a Camp Scholarship. Each Scholarship will be a maximum of \$200 and will be sent to the camp of their choice upon proof of registration.

Fraternal Concerns Fund

The Foundation Board of Trustees has set up a fund to assist members when a catastrophe strikes a member such as a casualty or uninsured theft loss of over \$5,000 not covered by insurance. The amount to the member is 10% of the balance in the fund up to a maximum of \$500 and not less than \$100. Any member would be limited to one Fraternal Concern per calendar year.

Grangers Attending State Session (GASS Fund)

The Foundation has established a fund in honor of past delegates and members who have attended the State Convention. The Foundation at it's annual luncheon meeting will distribute the income on this fund in increments of \$25 depending on the amount of income earned. Names of those attending the annual meeting will be placed in the drawing and you must be present to win.
