Glossary of Terms

<u>Affiliate</u>: A class of Grange membership. A Grange member who joins a second Community and/or Pomona Grange

<u>Annual Word</u>: Also call the password or annual password is a method used to prove Grange membership. The annual word changes every year at the annual meeting of the National Grange

<u>Associate</u>: A class of Grange membership. A person or business with an interest in the advancement of agriculture and improvement of rural life. Associate members do not have a voice or vote in Grange meetings

Charter: The official document that establishes a Grange

Code: See Unwritten Work

<u>Degrees</u>: Ceremonies celebrated to pass members to higher levels of the Grange. There are seven degrees of Grange membership. Each degree is a short ceremony that teaches a lesson through the lens of agriculture. The Subordinate/Community Grange celebrates the 1st through 4th degrees, the Pomona Grange is responsible for the 5th degree, State Granges the 6th Degree and the National Grange celebrates the 7th Degree

<u>Digest of Laws (Digest)</u>: The codified laws, rules and regulations of the Grange. Includes the Constitution, Articles of Incorporation, By-laws of the National Grange

<u>Family Plan</u>: A class of Grange membership. A family plan consists of a couple and their dependents, or a single person and their dependents. Dependents are defined as children, grand-children, great grandchildren, foster, adopted or step-children under the age of 23, who live as a member of the same household or in absence due to illness, education or military service. Legal dependents of any age shall be considered part of their legal guardians' family.

<u>Fraternal</u>: A class of Grange membership. This is the original or primary membership of a Grange member.

Golden Sheaf: A Grange member who has achieved 50 years of continuous membership

Installation: The ceremony used when officers are elected into their positions

<u>Junior Grange</u>: A division of the organization for children ages 5 to 14 (13½)

<u>Junior 1+</u>: A Junior Grange age member $(5 - 13\frac{1}{2})$ who joins a Subordinate Grange as an individual Junior member

<u>Manual</u>: A book containing the rituals and instructions on running Grange meetings. Each level of the Grange has its own manual

<u>Obligation</u>: The pledge given when joining the Subordinate/Community Grange as well as when joining higher degrees.

<u>Pomona</u>: One of the three lady Graces. Also, the county or district level of the Grange, responsible for celebrating the 5th Degree

<u>Ritual</u>: Ceremonies that are used to open & close meeting, install officers and initiate new members. Grange ritual shares moral lessons through the lens of agriculture

Secret Work: See Unwritten Work

Silver Star: A Grange member who has achieved 25 years of continuous membership

<u>Unwritten Work</u>: Instructions for Grange Ritual and ceremonies, written in the form of a lettered code with an accompanying cipher
