- Make a poster describing the animal's name, age, favorite foods, how much it grew in 3 months, what you did to care for it. Include pictures, and share with your Grange.





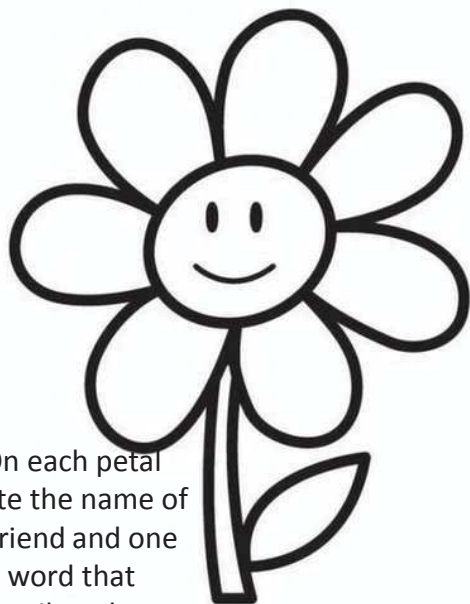

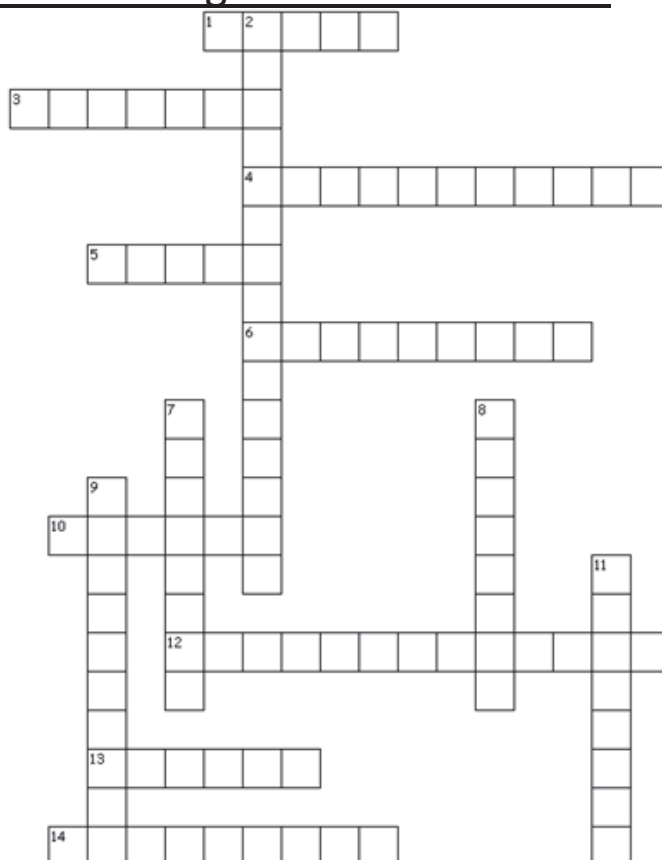

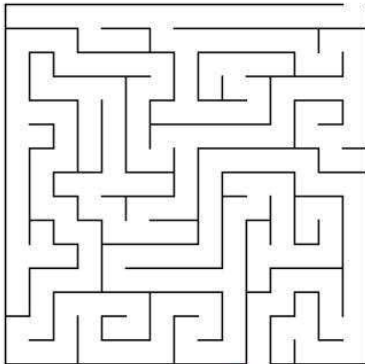
