



# Junior Group Activity

## Candy Ball

Time: 10-15 minutes

Group Size: 10-30

The candy ball is a great game, though it does require some prep and cleanup. It's easy to play and everyone is guaranteed a prize by the end.

What you will need: **Shrink wrap** (found in the packing supplies aisle at most all-in-one stores). You could use cellophane, though it isn't recommended. **A bag of candy or small plastic prizes.** The act of creating the candy ball will create pressure on the items so do not use anything fragile. Start with a piece of candy and begin wrapping it with shrink wrap. Every one or two wraps add another piece. It is very important to cut the shrink wrap every few passes and start in another portion of the ball. This will make sure that one person cannot unwind the entire ball and it will create start and stop points to increase the difficulty.

Rules: Have everyone sit in a circle facing each other. The first person will begin unwrapping the ball. As they are doing this the rest of the group will clap their hands as they count to ten. When the group reaches ten the person will pass the ball to the next person. The game will continue until the ball has been completely unwrapped and the final piece has been revealed.
