### Pillowcases for our Troops

- Sponsored by Gail Wilson
- Rules: Case must be for a standard-sized pillow.
- Fabric print can be appropriate for a man or woman.
- All pillowcases will be donated to our armed forces stationed abroad. Purchased pillowcases may be donated but not judged. A "Thank You for Serving our Country" card signed for the members of the Oregon State Grange will accompany the pillowcase.
- Judged on workmanship, comfort and appearance.
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$25, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$15, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$10 (plus ribbons)

### Crocheted Doilies

- Sponsored by Spencer Creek Grange #855
- Rules: Crochet thread **only**
- Judged on workmanship and design
- 1st place: \$25, 2nd place: \$15, 3rd place: \$10 (plus ribbons)

### Preemie Afghan & Hat

- Sponsored by Jan Oleson
- Categories: 1: Knitted  
2: Crocheted
- Rules: Block maximum size 12 inches square, Hat circumference: 10 inches.
- Judged on workmanship, neatness and skill
- Sponsor wishes item to be donated to a local hospital in the host district, unless requested to be returned
- 1st place: \$25, 2nd place: \$15, 3rd place: \$10 (plus ribbons)
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### Crocheted or Knitted Afghan

- Sponsored by the Parrott family in memory of Grandma Irene Godfrey
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$25, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$15, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$10 (plus ribbons)

### Miscellaneous Crocheted or Knitted Items

- Rules: Made from any type of fabric; crocheted or knitted. Can be any size or shape.
- Judged on neatness, design and workmanship
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$25, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$15, 3<sup>rd</sup> place \$10 (plus ribbons)

## Embroidery

- Sponsor Julie Schnetzky
- Rules: May use any kind of thread
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons)

### Counted Cross Stitch

- Sponsored by Parkdale Grange #500
- Rules: Stitched area no smaller than 3 x 3 inches or larger than 11 x 17 inches. Any canvas count and type. Back of work does not have to be visible for judging.
- Judged on merits of design, use of color, and craftsmanship
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons)

### Plastic Canvas

- Sponsored by Beaver Creek Grange #276
- Must be made within the past year.
- Judged on workmanship, creativity, neatness and skill
- 1st place: \$15, 2nd place: \$10, 3rd place: \$5 (plus ribbons)

### Quillow

- Sponsored by Forest Grove Grange #282
- Rules: Any size, Fabric only. Must be made by contestant within the past year.
- Sponsor wants items to be donated to the Oregon Foster Parents' Association unless requested to be returned.
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons)

### Apron

- Groups:
  1. Junior member between ages of 5 and 14 years; sponsored by Marilyn Reiher
  2. Member or non-member 14 years or older; sponsored by Beaver Creek Grange #276
- Rules: May use any pattern and any material suitable to the kind of apron. Must be made by contestant within past year.
- Judged on workmanship and serviceability
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons) for each group

### Hot Pad or Mitt

- Sponsored by Bailey Noah
- Categories 1: Crocheted or knitted  
2: Any kind of fabric
- Rules: Any shape or size, using any brand of yarn or thread. May be a mitt or a handle holder, and be backed with fire resistant material. Must be made by contestant within the past year.

- Judged on usefulness, color combinations and neatness
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons) for each category

## **Purses and Totes**

- Sponsored by Malcolm and Cookie Trupp
- Fabric (any kind); judged together
- Rules: Must be made by contestant within the past year.
- Judged on workmanship, neatness, originality and skill
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons)

## **Baby Quilt**

- Sponsored by Sauvies Island Grange #840
- Categories 1: Machine quilted by one  
2: Tied by one
- Must be made by contestant within the past year.
- Judged on workmanship, neatness, and skill.
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons)

## **Embroidered Baby Quilt**

- Sponsored by Walterville Grange #416
- Rules: Must be made by contestant in the past year
- Judged on craftsmanship, design and neatness
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons)

## **Quilts**

- Sponsored by Siletz Valley Grange #558
- Categories 1: Hand quilted by one  
2: Machine quilted by one  
3: Tied by one or group
- Rules: Minimum size 72 x 90 inches and maximum 120 x 120 inches. Must be made by contestant(s) within the past year.
- Judged on workmanship, neatness, and skill
- For hand quilted: 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$25, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$15, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$10 (plus ribbons)  
For machine quilted and tied by one or group: 1<sup>st</sup> place: \$15, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$5 (plus ribbons)
