

## **NEW Junior Grange Jeopardy**

(National Contest)

Junior Grange Jeopardy brings together Junior Grangers who are interested in Grange history and trivia.

Participants have the opportunity to gain knowledge about the history of the Grange and Junior Grange and their impact on rural America while enhancing their critical thinking, problem solving, communications and listening skills.

- Participants must be 5 to 14 years of age by December 31 of the competition year.
- During the State Convention, up to three contestants may be selected to compete as an individual at the National Grange Convention.
- Contestants will earn points for each correct answer and lose points for incorrect answers. There will be three rounds: two regular and Final Jeopardy.
- Contestants can move on to Final Jeopardy only if they have at least one point on the score board.
- The three contestants with the highest scores will win a cash prize.

If an Oregon contestant is selected to participate at the National Grange Convention in Stowe, Vermont in November, contact the State Junior Directors to coordinate travel with others attending; the contestant's family is responsible for all costs.
