

State Junior Officers

During the annual convention of the Oregon State Junior Grange, many activities are planned for the benefit of the Juniors in attendance. These include educational tours, contests, and the conferral of the Junior Degree by the State Junior Officers on Tuesday morning June 26.

Children ages of 5 and 14 may apply to be a State Junior Officer. The application form can be downloaded from www.orgrange.org/juniors/. Applications sent to the Oregon State Grange office (643 Union St NE, Salem 97301) or submitted to JRdir@orgrange.org **before March 31** will be given first consideration. However, if any offices are vacant, applications will be accepted until the first day of the convention. The State Junior committee will select the officers and inform the applicants of the office for which they have been selected.

All officers will need to attend the State Junior Convention Saturday June 23 through Thursday June 28. Officers with speaking parts in the opening, closing, and degree work are **required to have their parts memorized** upon arrival at the State Grange Convention.

For the conferral of the degree on Tuesday morning June 26, male officers will be required to wear a white long-sleeved button-up shirt, black slacks, and red shoes.

Female officers will be required to wear a white blouse, black skirt or black slacks, and red shoes.

A Junior may not hold the same office two consecutive years.
