Applications will be evaluated as follows:

- Lane Pomona Grange offers a \$1,000 scholarship for a deserving college or vocational student, second year or beyond, enrolled in 6 units or more, who is a member of, or the child or grandchild of a member of Lane Pomona Grange or of any Lane Pomona Subordinate Grange. (*Membership Status: 20 points possible*)
- The Scholarship Committee will give preference to active members of Lane Pomona Grange and/or the Subordinate Granges of Lane County. (*Grange involvement: 20 points possible*)
- Applicants must be enrolled in 6 or more units. (*Academic profile: 20 points possible*)
- Community involvement and/or personal commitment and responsibility will be considered by the committee. (*Community service: 20 points possible*)

Additional Information:

- Awarding of the scholarship will be the responsibility of the Lane Pomona Scholarship Committee, to be appointed by the Lane Pomona Grange Master on an annual basis. Decisions of the committee will be final, and the scholarship may or may not be awarded, depending on the quality and number of applicants.
- Applicants and/or recipients may reapply in subsequent years.
- The scholarship will be paid to the student's account at the educational institution they are attending, upon receipt of proof of enrollment for the next term after the scholarship award.
- Scholarship recipients are asked to be present for recognition at the October Pomona Grange meeting following their award or at the Annual Lane Pomona Grange Scholarship fundraising dinner.
