Honor Grange Program

Subordinate/Community Granges

The **Honor Grange Program** is to recognize those Subordinate/Community Granges that are succeeding in being an exemplary Grange. This means making an impact on your community and having active members. The **Honor Grange Program** has three levels: **Bronze, Silver** and **Gold**. Each Oregon Grange will have an opportunity to win a plaque when it first achieves one of these levels. Each year thereafter, if the Grange qualifies, it will receive a bronze, silver or gold bar with the year of the award engraved to attach to the plaque.

To receive an award, each Grange must keep track of its progress on the Qualification form for one year from January to December. The Grange should designate one member to be Tracker. At the end of the year, the Tracker will send the qualification form to Oregon State Grange Office postmarked by March 31, 2022 along with a brief narrative of what level the Grange has achieved. The plaques or bars will be awarded at the June State Session. *We look forward to presenting your Grange with an award!*

The awards will be based on your completion of the criteria as listed on the following two pages and judging will include the recap of your Grange events. Please complete that recap, specifying what award you believe you should receive and the items you have completed to qualify for it. The recap should include a brief description of each item you have checked as completed.
