Memorial Scholarship Application

This scholarship was established by Mrs. Ramm's daughters to honor their mother and her commitment to education. Mary graduated at age 16 from high school in 1941 but put off college until after World War II. She first started college in 1948 to study history and education but was forced to quit school for both financial reasons as well as to help on the family farm and was not able to return to school until 1960. She graduated from Central Washington College of Education in the summer of 1961. She went on to teach elementary school. Mary was a history buff and during the last year of her life she spent many hours on the family history and genealogy.

At this time the scholarship will be a minimum of \$250 and will be paid directly to the winner upon proof of registration to use for any college expenses.

The Foundation reserves the right not to award the scholarship in any given year. Previous winners may reapply.

Scholarship requirements:

1. Female Student
2. Must be a Grange member in good standing
3. Returned/returning to college after a 3 year break (must have a minimum 3 year break in their college classes)
4. Undergraduate or graduate student, open to all qualifying students but priority given to students majoring in Education, History or Family History/Genealogy
5. Complete Application
6. Maximum 500 word statement of need, goals and personal information including:
 - Leadership positions you hold/have held in organizations in your school and community.
 - Participation in community service activities in your community
 - List awards or honors received in the past 5 years
 - Tell us about your family situation (husband/children/grandchildren, etc.)
7. Copies of previous and current college transcripts (does not need to be certified) and letter of acceptance if not currently in school
8. Two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a member of your Grange

Scholarship application must be **postmarked by May 1** to the **Oregon State Grange office** at the below address. The winner of the scholarship will be announced at the annual Foundation Banquet held in at the Oregon State Grange Convention.
