

## Junior Historian Award

The new Junior Historian Award is the highest level of achievement an individual Junior Grange member may obtain. The purpose of the award is to challenge Junior Grange members to learn and become fluent in the Rituals and History of our organization.

The candidate must send a completed application, including the Junior Historian Knowledge written test and proof of completion of requirements, to the National Junior Director postmarked no later than **August 15**: See [www.orgrange.org/juniors/](http://www.orgrange.org/juniors/) for the test and requirements.

A special recognition and certificate will be presented to each Junior Grange member who meets the requirements. The Junior Historian applications and documentation will be displayed at the National Grange Convention and those receiving the award will be recognized at the Junior Grange Breakfast.
