

National GROW Club Scholarship

Who is eligible? A Grange member in good standing who is a full-time student enrolled in a college, university, community college, technical institution or trade school.

Where can the scholarship be used?

The recipient can pay educational expenses at any college, university, community college, technical institution or trade school.

What is the application process?

Complete the application, which can be downloaded from www.orgrange.org/scholarships/, answering all questions and providing the required attachments. The total application including attachments must not exceed ten single-sided pages. The complete application with all required attachments must be sent in one package.

Attachments include:

- Official transcript: Graduating high school seniors must submit their high school transcript. Those who have completed any semesters of college and are currently enrolled in college must submit an official college transcript.
- One letter of recommendation from a leader in your Subordinate/Community Grange, who is not your relative.
- One letter of recommendation from your State Master.
- One Letter of recommendation from a source other than a relative.
- Signed statement by applicant and guardian.

When is the deadline?

Complete applications with attachments must be mailed to the National Youth Director postmarked no later than **September 1**.

Who selects the recipient?

The National GROW Club Board will select a recipient based solely on the application. The chosen recipient will be notified by October 1. The scholarship winner will be announced at the GROW Club Luncheon during the National Grange Convention.

How much is the scholarship?

At least one \$500 scholarship will be awarded. Additional scholarships may be awarded if funds are available.
